Day 2(04-01-2017):

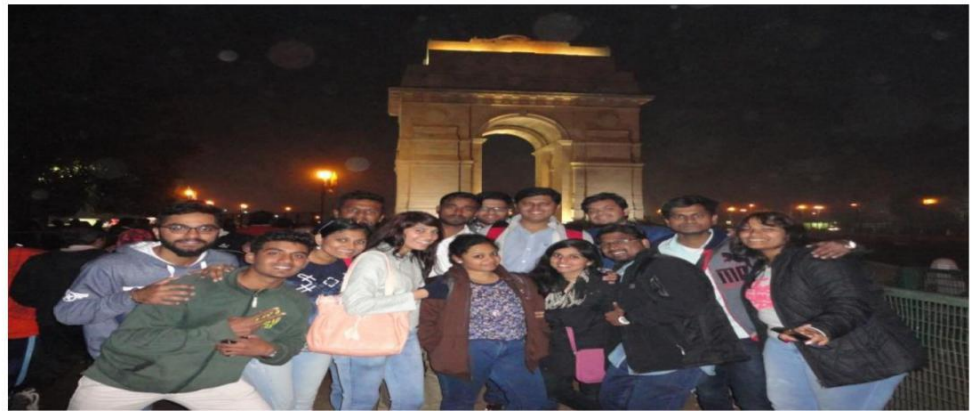

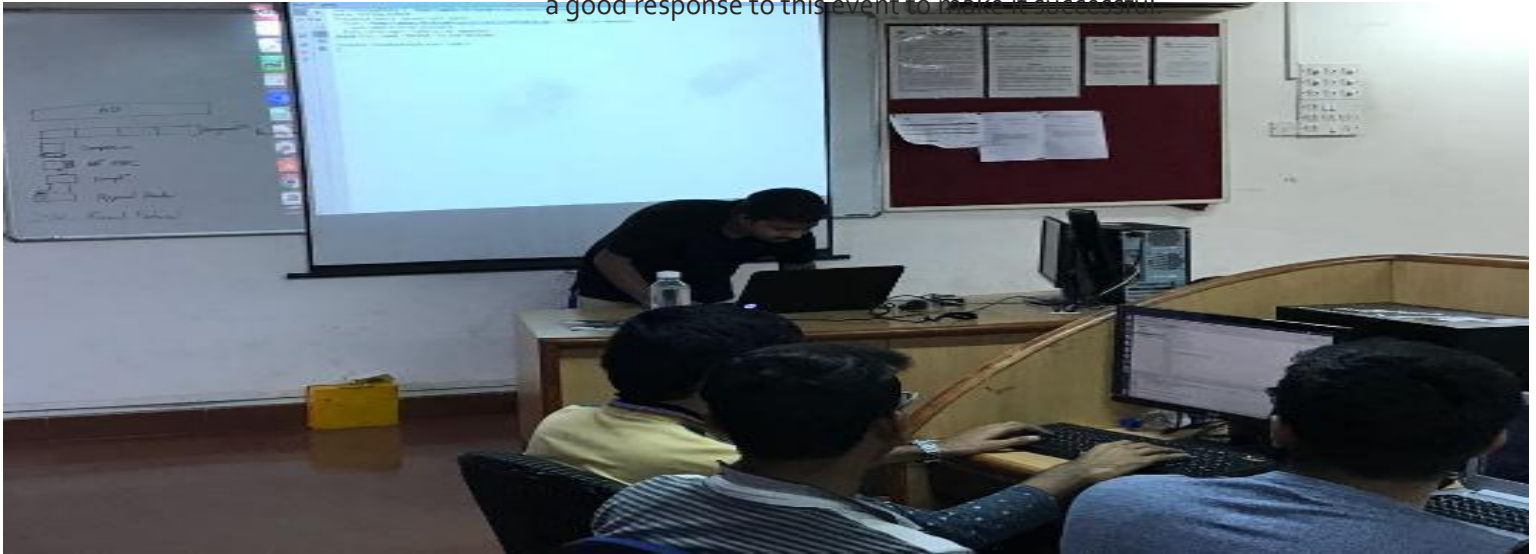
Day 9(11-01-2017):
